About the Project:

The TRANS-SAFE Project is a Research and Innovation Action project funded by the European Union under the Climate, Energy and Mobility topic of the Horizon Europe Framework Programme. The project is developing and implementing pilot demonstration projects to test the implementation of a safe system approach on road safety at the national, regional and city levels in Ghana, Rwanda, South Africa and Zambia. Beyond these countries, the project now seeks to undertake preparatory works for implementing road safety demonstration actions in Botswana. In this regard, the project aims to:

- Conduct a review of national and local level policies and regulations as well as strategies, initiatives, programmes and projects related to road safety management and implementation in Botswana.
- Conduct an analysis of the current state of integration of the Safe Systems approach in Botswana on a national and city level. The Safe System approach shall follow the type adopted by the project.
- Undertake a review on the implementation of post-crash care policies and interventions in Botswana.
- Develop a concept note to propose demonstration actions including road safety measures and low-cost interventions addressing the road safety challenges and gaps identified in the review and analysis described above.

Note: This is a fellowship position, and candidates will be selected based on their qualifications and commitment to the project's goals. We actively encourage women to apply for this position.
